

## Invitation to Swedish Championship Supermoto 2025

*We invite all riders to the Swedish Championship in Supermoto. The races are considered an international race and is open to anyone with a license provided by FIM Europe.*

### Calendar 2025

Our races are open to foreign riders as well. Riders from countries outside Sweden must have:

- International license
- Starting permission from their federation
- A personal profile in Svemo TA (event administration)
- Registration as soon as possible, latest day of entry is two weeks before the race

### Entry procedure

To enter/sign up for a race must be done through Svemo TA (event administration) for the Swedish Championship. Riders not having a user profile in the system need to create a login as soon as possible. Use the following link:

## Entry procedure at the event

In order to practice or race, you need to sign in at the race office to verify license and payment. The race office has the sign "Anmälan" in front. They will verify license, payment and provide a race program for the weekend. The program contains information about timing, rules and mandatory riders meetings for the event.

The general procedure for a race weekend is open training on Saturday and races on Sunday, except for the last race in Borås, when training is on Friday and races on Saturday. This may be subject to change and will be confirmed in the race program and riders meetings.

## Status and classes

All races are part of the Swedish Championship in Supermoto. The following classes are available:

### Elit

The official Swedish Championship where the overall winner is the Swedish Champion

### Open

A supportclass open for anyone with a racing license in Supermoto

### Ladies "Open Dam"

A women only supportclass. Run together with the open class.

### Youth "Ungdom"

Young riders on bikes 125 cc, 12 – 16 years. Run together with Open and Ladies

### Youth "Supermini"

Young riders on bikes 80 cc, 7 – 15 years.

### Youth "Guld hjälm"

Young riders on bikes 50 – 65 cc, 5 – 11 years.

### Asphalt cup "Asfaltscupen"

Will be offered in Södertälje, Västerås and Borlänge. A separate supportclass with no gravel sections.

### 40+

An "oldtimer" only for riders older than 40 years. Will be offered in Örebro, Strängnäs and Borås.

## Entry fee per class

- Elit 1 800 SEK
- Open, Open Ladies 1 500 SEK
- Ungdom 900 SEK
- Supermini 600 SEK
- Guldhjälms 600 SEK
- Asfaltscup 1 500 SEK
- 40+ 1 500 SEK
- Training fee 300 SEK
- Electricity during the weekend included in the entry fee
- Transponder rent 300 SEK  
*(if not using your own. Personal identification will need to be deposited as security until the transponder is returned, failure to return the transponder and holder will lead to full reimbursement cost for the rider)*

## Technical inspection

All bikes and helmets need to pass the technical inspection in order to be allowed to race. The inspection will be held in a separate area marked Technical Control or "Besiktning" for each race. The safety inspection includes:

- No visible damage or unreasonable wear to the helmet
- Catch tank for all fluids
- Safety wire of all bolts for drain and fill of fluids and brake calipers
- Noise level

## Riders meeting

Each day will begin with a riders meeting that is mandatory for all riders. The meeting will cover timing schedule, any changes from the official program, safety rules and Q&A. Note that changes and decisions may take place at the meetings and it's your responsibility to make sure that you are aware of these. The meetings generally held in Swedish but translation can be offered at your request.

## Price ceremony

The prize giving ceremony take place approximately 30 minutes after the last race has finished, at the prize podium.
